Minutes of Meeting**

It was mentioned that we have to be consistent in abating and it was tabled until the next meeting until it is further investigated.

Gregory Cloutier – to put a small theater in the building next to the Rialto.

Sign Permit:

Rialto Theater – for new sign for new theater.

It was brought up about the intervening of the Northern Pass and Mr. Rideout stated that it was to late to sign on.

It was also brought up about the Public Hearing on February 22<sup>nd</sup> regarding funding for Solar

Panels for the town. This is an informational meeting and Tim Southworth has done a lot of work on it to see what the Town could do with this project.
