NEW BUSINESS:

Approve Emergency Operations Plan Update

There was an Administrative Document to be signed by the Selectboard and Department Heads. It was noted that the Department Heads had gone through the document to see or make any changes necessary.

OTHER BUSINESS:

It was asked about the progress of the round-about. Mr. Samson stated that it was to be open to full traffic on Wednesday (the 21st). There was some discussion regarding the corners sticking out and a sidewalk. Leon Rideout stated that he had asked that the sidewalk not be put there.

Alan Savage again brought up about his land in current use with the solar panels on it and what was the Board to do about the taxing issue. He was told that they have not seen any documentation from Jason Call and until they do and are able to go over it they cannot make a final decision. Leon Rideout stated that the Board will have some answers by the October 3rd meeting. Mr. Savage stated that he had stated previously to the Board and Mr. Call that he be present when he came to his land and he goes there when no one is home.

It was asked if all of the street lights were done and Mr. Samson stated that there were a few left to do, but they will be taken care of shortly.

It was stated that the solar panels at the Transfer Station and Chlorinator Plant are up and running, the one at the Lagoon will be on line soon.

Noting that there was no further business to come before the meeting, a motion was called for to adjourn.

A motion was made by Leo Enos and seconded by Leon Rideout to adjourn. A vote was taken and the meeting adjourned at 7:00 P.M.
