

**Board of Selectmen
Minutes of Meeting.**

Meeting held upstairs in Town Hall

Monday -September 8, 2015t

Attending: Town Manager Edward Samson
Selectmen David Stickney and Leo Enos (Leon Rideout was absent)

Others: Murray Vashaw and Alan Savage.

The meeting was called to order by David Stickney at 6:30 P.M., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Appointments: None

Old Business:

To review and approve the August 17th regular meeting and the August 24th meeting for the opening of the fuel bids.

A motion was made by Leo Enos and seconded by David Stickney to approve both the August 17th and the August 24, 2015 minutes as written. A vote was taken and the motion carried.

Mr. Samson read the bids for those present at the meeting.

Four bids were received. The bid from Rymes was not accepted as it was two hours late.

Mr. Savage stated that the bids were not all the same as some did not give and over rack price. He was told that they were all given the same opportunity to bid and this what they presented.

A motion was made by Leo Enos and seconded by David Stickney to award the bid for the #2 Fuel Oil and the Propane to CN Brown. A vote was taken and the motion carried.

New Business:

Opening of winter sand bids.

Mr. Samson stated that there were three bids received.

Carroll Concrete - \$7.35 per ton delivered

Beattie Enterprise - \$8.75 per yard delivered- 6,000 tons continuous until complete.

Will average out to \$7.00 per ton.

Cloutier Contractor - \$7.91 per ton - 6,000 ton

It was also stated that Shane Beattie had asked for a sand test. There were three samples done and the last was better or just as good as the first. David Stickney stated that Leo Enos, Denis Donnelly, and Edward Samson were at the test. Alan Savage stated that Beattie does not have a scale and it wouldn't be possible to make sure you got the right amount, he also stated that Cloutier has washed concrete sand. After some discussion a vote was called for.

A motion was made by David Stickney and seconded by Leo Enos to award the winter sand bid to Beattie Enterprise. A vote was taken and the motion carried.

A letter was read from William Potter, Chairman of the Zoning Board to appoint Rick Bernier, and Alternate to a Regular member due to the resignation of Nancy Colborn who has moved out of town. This would only be to complete her term ending in March 2017.

A motion was made by David Stickney and seconded by Leo Enos to accept the recommendation of Zoning Chairman William Potter. A vote was taken and the motion carried.
