

**Board of Selectmen
Minutes of Meeting**

Meeting held upstairs in Town Hall

Monday – October 16, 2017

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Leo Enos at 6:30 PM followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPOINTMENTS: None

OLD BUSINESS:

To Review and approve the minutes of the October 2, 2017 meeting.

A motion was made by Leon Rideout and seconded by David Stickney to approve the minutes as written. A vote was taken and the motion carried.

Department Head Updates: None

Signing of various paperwork:

The Tax Collector had presented the Warrant for the Water and Sewer in the amount of \$419,705.25 for the Selectmen's review and signature.

Abatement's:

Stan & Sally Knecht 159 Main St. \$28.80 (\$15.00 w – \$18.80 s) This was on the 2nd billing – the barn usage was not taken off of the house usage.

Rob Cote Land Partnership 100 Bridge St. \$230.40 (\$120.00 w - \$110.40 s) - the campground usage was not taken off of the store usage.

Nancy Kingston 21 Elm St. .50 invoice entered wrong.

Town of Lancaster – Julie Pebbles 54 Depot St.

\$185.00 (\$105.00 w - \$80.00 s) on 2nd billing the Town owned the property. Ms. Pebbles will start paying in the spring of 2018.

The Board signed all of the above paperwork.

It was asked if there was a way to not double bill the meters, after some discussion it was decided to look further into the problem.

INFORMATION:

A building permit was issued to Sally Craft 126 Reed Road Permit #17-041
Install a 12 kW roof mounted solar PV array on existing barn.

There was a lot of discussion on the Summer St. Project. It was stated that it was

not going as well as expected. Some of the things that were to be done might not be done until the spring. There was a conflict with the laying of the water and sewer lines. Also they got started late. Hopefully they will be able to get the top coat done by mid November. People have complained a lot that the signage on the streets has not been very good. They are suppose to pave the sidewalk on North Main St. this week. Leo Enos stated that he had asked Central Paving to do part of his driveway and he wanted it noted that he is paying for that part of the project not the Town.

There was discussion on the sidewalks for Main St. Mr. Samson stated that they would be done in the spring due to the weather now.

Mr. Samson stated that he would like a Non=Public Session according to RSA 91-A:3 with the Selectmen on a personnel issue. They set the meeting for Thursday October 19, 2017 at 10:00 AM in the Town Managers office.
