Signing of various paperwork:

Abatements:

- John Burbach, 40 Water St for \$3.94 on 2nd issue of property tax it didn't show that it was paid in full.
- Michael & Barbara Rossell, 20 Wegomlegging Lane for \$8.51. Ms. Rossell spoke to the Selectboard regarding the issue. She had gotten a letter that stated that there could be a lien on the property for the \$8.51 amount. She felt that the process could have been handled in a better way. Mr. Samson stated that there was a posting error and it had been taken care of and the Board stated that they would look at having a better letter drawn up in case there were issues of others in the future. There was a good discussion between Ms. Rossell and the Board.
- State of New Hampshire, Elm St. for \$1,219.94 (1st issue being \$233.94 & 2nd issue being \$986.00). This land is still in the ownership of the State and the State is in the process of officially turning it over to Forbes Family Partnership.

Intent to Cut:

- Forbes Family Partnership R9 Lot 31,32 & 41. to be cut by Scott Forbes. They have been clearing out around the property. To cut 15 of 481 acres.

New Business:

Service Agreement with Ainsworth Land Management

This is the Forest Management Plan that the Town has with him. Cost \$2,800.00.

It was asked if there were any projected cuts planned and the answer was that the Board was not aware of any at this time.

Pole License by Fair/Point and Eversource for area on Bunker Hill St.

The Board of Selectmen signed all of the above paperwork that was needed.
