Joe Fitzgerald asked if there had been any more discussion on using the vacant lot for trees, and Mr. Samson stated that it had not been addressed as yet. It was also asked if there had been a decision made as to when the trees would be planted. Mr. Samson stated that they had to work on one thing at a

time, a lot depends on the construction season.

Mr. Fitzgerald stated that those who are saying that the town is not concerned as to what goes on are wrong, he feels that the Selectmen and Town Manager are very concerned and responsible to the town. Mr. Samson stated that some people don't like the answers that are given to them. It was further asked about the Dow Fund and Mr. Samson stated that it was no longer in existence and was put into the welfare fund.

Mr. Cotton stated that more attention needs to be given to the appearance of Main St.
